PRACTICAL DETAILS

Positions to be filled ideally in March 2021.

The initial contracts will be for 2 years, renewable.

You will be based in Brussels with possible regular international travel and occasional work in unusual hours.

The successful candidates will be recruited as Contract agents in Function Group III, step depending on years of experience. Salary and allowances, under the EU institutions system, depend on experience, country of origin and family situation. We offer extensive and continuous training opportunities for development.
